Government hospital, **medical superintendent** who is **appointed by** ministry of health manages the hospital.

Military hospital is managed by commanding officer, while a private hospital usually has an organized governing body

Most hospitals are run on a nonprofit basis by governments or charities.

A district hospital typically is the major health care facility in its region,

Clinics generally provide only outpatient services

Surgery department deals with the removal or replacement of a diseased organ or tissue or removal of an organ for preventive purposes

Gynecology department deals with the functions and diseases specific to women and girls, especially those who have reproductive system problems.

Orthopedic departments treat problems that affect your skeletal system

ENT allergy problems, salivary gland diseases, voice disorders.

Cardiology department provides medical care to patients who have problems with their heart or circulation

Dermatology department deals diagnosis and treatment of skin related diseases.

Neurology department deals with disorders of the nervous system, including the brain and spinal cord.

Urology department investigates all areas linked to kidney and bladder-based problems.

The prescription to inpatients is called medication order.

There are four systems used for drug distribution in a hospital

Under Complete floor stock system, the nursing station pharmacy carries both “charge” and “non-charge” patient medications

Records must be retained for at least the length of time prescribed by law

Public health is the study and practice of how best to improve the overall health, and health gains, of populations rather than individuals.

Epidemiology is a set of tools for understanding the burden and causes of health problems in human populations

There are three essential components in the chain of infection

Pharmacy layout is the components of the physical facilities of a pharmacy.
